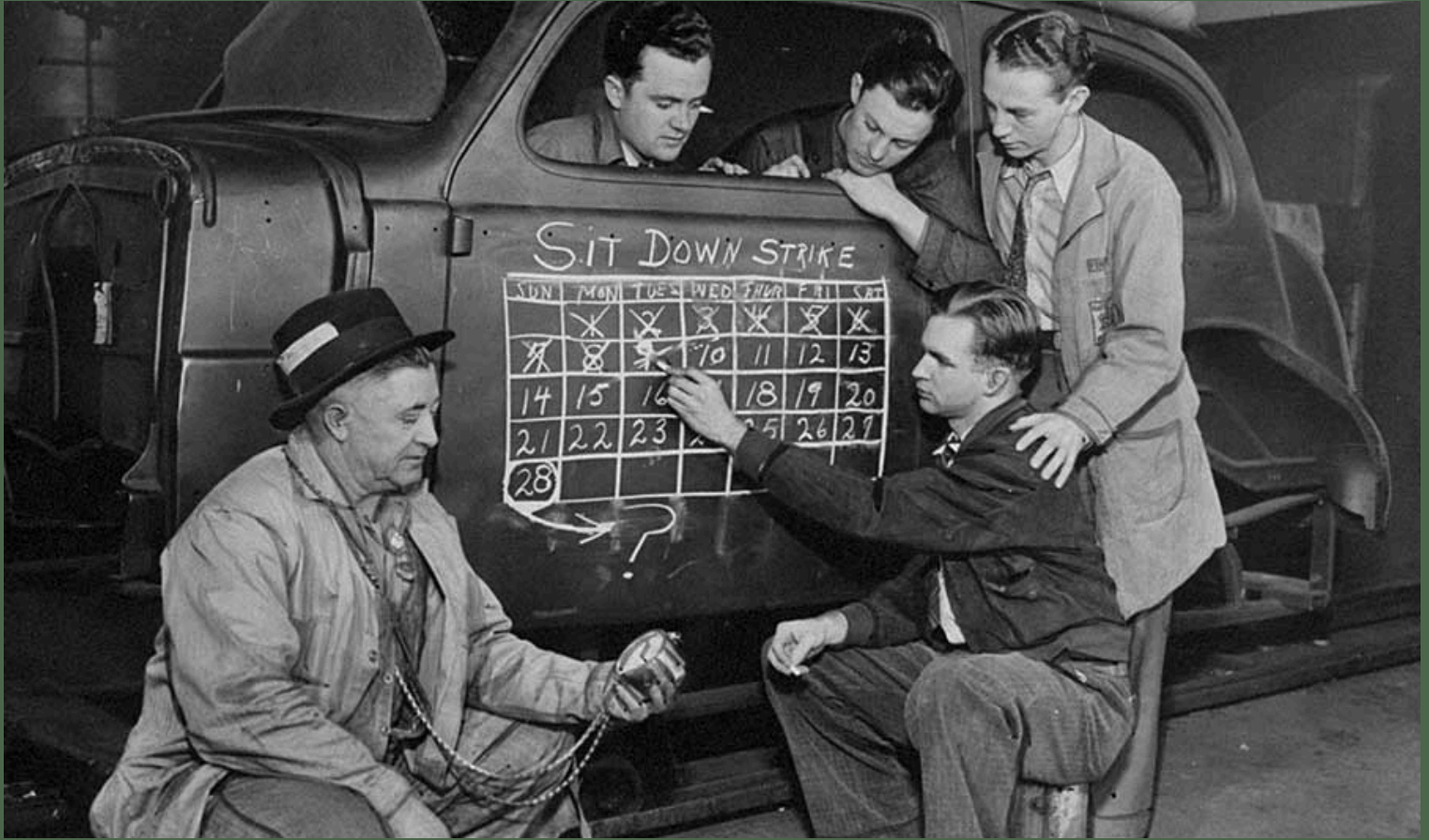


GETTING “STRIKE READY”

A Workshop Presented By The South Central Federation of Labor



Each year union strikes have nearly doubled since 2020 with some of the largest industry wide strikes the United States has seen in decades occurring in the past year. While very few labor-management disputes result in strikes - it is important for workers and unions to know how to get “strike ready.” Effective strikes take months to over a year of preparation. In addition, the work of building solidarity can make a strike unnecessary, while at the same time strengthening worker solidarity for future struggles.

In this workshop, we will discuss legal protections and pitfalls, mapping leverage points and allies, building a strike structure, and using “structure tests” to check your readiness.
