Assistance for Fired Federal Workers and Other Displaced Professionals

As hundreds of workers at various federal agencies (or at agencies that receive federal funding) are having their employment terminated, Governor Evers, his administration, and the State of Wisconsin have established a new portal and additional resources to support and connect them with different employment opportunities. Federal workers or other displaced professionals can use the new portal to find in-demand, difficult-to-fill roles across Wisconsin. There also will be access to critical resources like job center services, unemployment benefits, and rapid response and dislocated worker programs designed to support workers who recently lost their jobs.
